(flavocoxid and citrated zinc bisglycinate) 500 mg/50 mg

(Limbrel 500mg, 250mg, 500-50mg, 250-50mg and 525mg)

The table below lists the side effects reported by patients and physicians in post-marketing surveillance, as reported from introduction in 2004 through current date. Reported cases of rash and itching may have been associated with allergies to Limbrel's flavonoid ingredients and were transient in nature. Hypersensitivity pneumonitis is a rare, but serious complication of Limbrel therapy. Thus far, with more than 500,000 people exposed to the product, 40 cases of Hypersensitivity pneumonitis have been reported (31 confirmed and 18 unconfirmed). Of the reported cases of elevated liver tests most were mild and without symptoms. However, 73 cases were associated with clinical jaundice and higher elevated liver function tests. All resolved without treatment after Limbrel was stopped.
